

AUT International House GIE Programme

AUT IH GIE is a 12-week intensive programme (24 contact hours per week/288 contact hours in total) that focuses on:

- Academic English language systems and skills
- Academic study skills
- IELTS preparation
- General English development

The GIE programme is aimed at international students preparing to enter university in an English speaking environment at pre-degree, undergraduate and post-graduate levels of study. The programme is run twice a year to feed into February and July semester starts.

GIE grades have equivalence with IELTS bands for entrance to AUT University programmes (except PhD, Health and Education).

Entry requirements:

<u>External students</u>: the minimum entry requirement is IELTS Academic module 5.5 overall band score, with a minimum of 5.5 in Reading and Writing bands and no other band below 5.0, or AUT IH GIE placement test required score.

Internal students: successful completion of Intermediate 3 or higher PLUS AUT IH GIE placement test required score.

Course composition:

The content of the course leads to the development of knowledge and use of academic English for university study. The areas of study are **Writing** and Research skills, **Reading** and vocabulary, **Listening** and note-taking, **Speaking** and presentation skills.

Assessment:

Assessment on the programme consists of:

- continuous 5 essays covering different genres
- mid-course and final exams in all 4 skills (integrated Reading, Listening and Writing component)
- Power-Point oral presentation of Research and
- written (group) Research Report (min 3000 words)

AUT International House GIE programme grade equivalences

IELTS (Academic) is the English Language requirement for the following AUT University programmes:

- Bachelor of Education and the Graduate Diploma in Secondary Teaching.
- Programmes of medical laboratory science, midwifery, nursing, occupational therapy, oral health, paramedicine, psychology, psychotherapy, podiatry, and physiotherapy.
